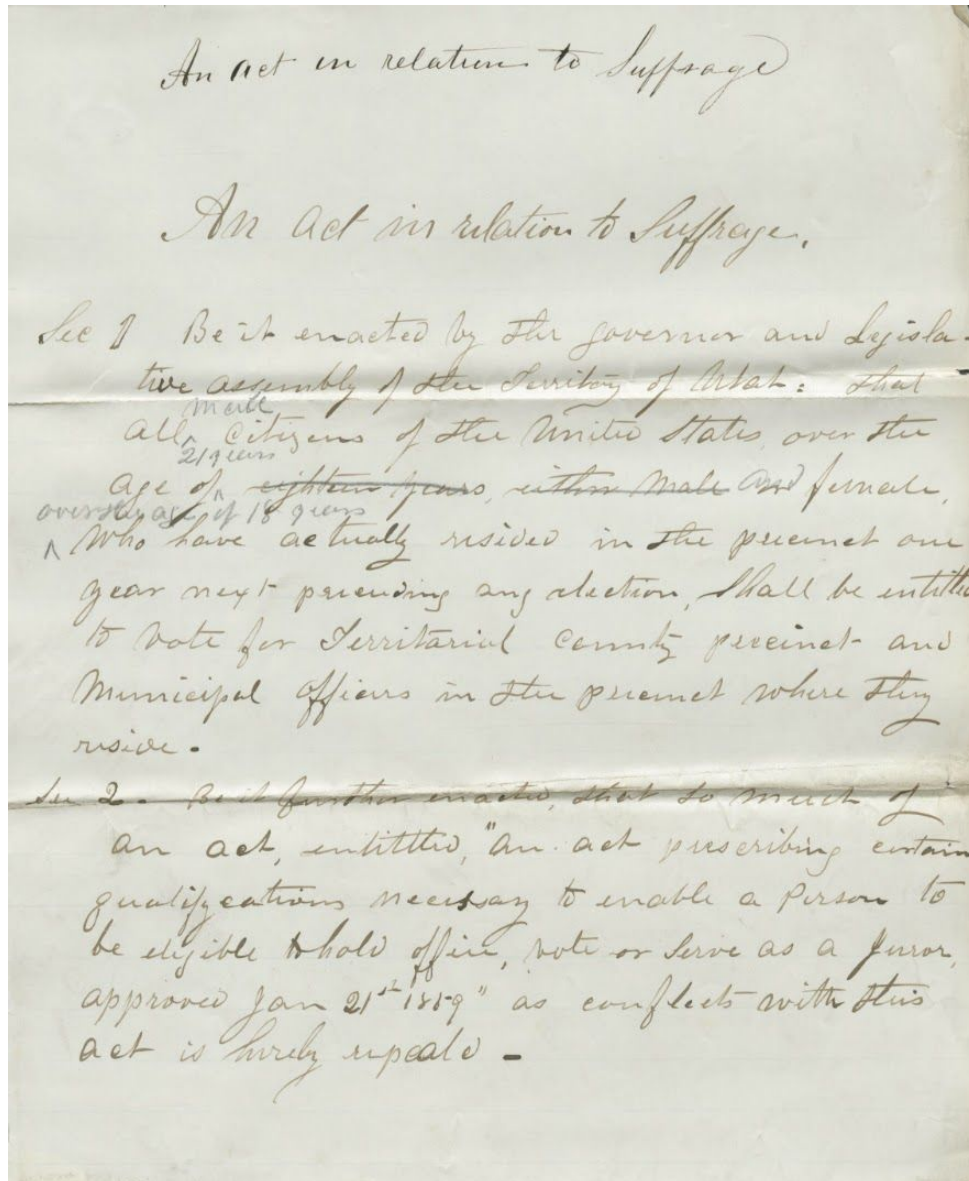


1870 Draft Suffrage Bill

An act in relation to Suffrage

Sec 1 Be it enacted by the governor and Legislative assembly of the Territory of Utah: that all ^{male} citizens of the United States over the age of ^{21 years} ~~eighteen years~~, either male and or female, ^{over the age of 18 years} who have actually resided in the precinct one year next preceding any election, shall be entitled to vote for Territorial county precinct and Municipal officers in the precinct where they reside.

Sec 2. Be it further enacted, that so much of an act, entitled, "an act prescribing certain qualifications necessary to enable a Person to be eligible to hold office, vote or serve as a Juror, approved Jan 21st 1859" as conflicts with this act is hereby repealed
